

KRRS Access Rules¹

KRRS members in good standing (i.e.: no money owing to the Society), **associate members** from the same property, **and their immediate family** (spouse or common-law partner; parents; grandparents; children; grand-children; brothers and sisters; daughters and sons; brothers and sisters in law; daughters in law and sons in law; and including all persons where the family relationships is adoptive, half, or step) **are entitled to unlimited use of the Access** (which includes all of its 'improvements, the dock, and the tenure area around the dock), **provided that such use is in accordance with the applicable bylaws, rules, and policies of the Society.**

The rules that apply to use of the Access are as follows:

- 1. Use of the Access by any person is contingent on their agreement that such use is ENTIRELY AT THEIR RISK, and that they agree to waive any claims that they may have against the Society and/or its' officers and directors that results from such use, however caused.**
2. Members, Associate Members, and their immediate family, may bring a **reasonable number** of guests with them onto the Access if:
 - They obtain the acknowledgement and agreement of each of guest to rule #1 above; and
 - **They accompany and supervise their guest(s) the entire time.**
3. Children on the Access must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a member, associate member, or an adult member of their immediate family.
4. Use of the Access is on a first come, first serve basis – there is no reserving of space on the beach, dock, or grass.
5. No Foul language, or rude, obnoxious, intimidating, or threatening behavior.
6. No pets.
7. No Glass containers.
8. No Smoking or e-vaping.
9. No playing of music or other media (listening quietly with headphones is okay).
10. Sunbathing, or the use of chairs, is not permitted on the dock during busy times.
11. Chairs, coolers, air mattresses, blow-up toys, or other items must not be left unattended on the dock.
12. You must take all your possessions (chairs, coolers, floaties, etcetera) and your trash and recyclables with you when you leave.
13. The gates at the beach, which are there to keep geese off the property, must be closed by the last person using the Access.
14. The entrance gate at Kawkawa Lake Road must be closed after each use.
15. No parking in front of the Access.
16. All bicycles and similar conveyances must be left at the top of the Access near the front fence.
17. As a member, associate member, or immediate family of a member, you are responsible for helping to maintain the Access, and are expected to volunteer your services when needed.
18. Any person who while on the Access suffers injury, or directly or indirectly causes injury to another, or who directly or indirectly causes damage to property not their own, or who witnesses any of the aforementioned, must immediately report the incident and its circumstances, including the identity of witnesses, to KRRS at krrsinfo@gmail.com.
19. KRRS members, associate members, or members of their immediate family who observe any non-compliance with any of the Society's bylaws, rules, or policies must report the occurrence to KRRS at krrsinfo@gmail.com.

Failure to follow the above rules may result in fines and/or suspension of membership privileges or membership.
