

## KRRS Moorage Rules <sup>1</sup>

**KRRS members** in good standing (i.e.: no money owing to the Society), **associate members and immediate family (defined as son or daughter)** from the same property, **may, free of charge, temporarily moor watercraft owned by them at the KRRS dock under the following terms and conditions.** **No guests may moor at the KRRS dock.** (3)

1. The mooring of watercraft at the dock and/or any use of the dock itself, is contingent on the owner and/or users' agreement that such USE IS ENTIRELY AT THEIR RISK, and that they agree to waive any claims that they may have against the Society and/or its' officers and directors, however caused, that results from such use, and that at all times WATERCRAFT MOORED AT THE DOCK REMAIN IN THE CUSTODY OF THEIR OWNER AND/OR USER, and not with the Society.
2. Watercraft moored at the dock over 12 feet in length or fitted with an engine or motor with a power rating of over 9.9 horsepower must be insured against loss and damage and have third party liability insurance of \$1,000,000 or more. This requirement applies to watercraft owned by all members, associate members, and immediate family (as specifically defined above). (3)
3. During busy times, watercraft moored at the dock must be in use on a daily basis.
4. Moorage is on a first-come, first served basis, and the reserving of space at the dock is not permitted except when a watercraft that was moored at the dock is out on the lake will be returning to the dock (indicated by bumpers tied to the boat's spot at the dock).
5. The fueling of watercraft on the Access, on the dock, or on boats moored to the dock, is prohibited.
6. Watercraft must be moored in a manner that makes efficient use of the available dock space.
7. Raft mooring is not permitted.
8. Any person who while on the Access, dock, or tenured water area suffers injury, or directly or indirectly causes injury to another, or who directly or indirectly causes damage to property not their own, or who witnesses any of the aforementioned, must immediately report the incident and its circumstances, including the identity of witnesses, to KRRS at [krrsinfo@gmail.com](mailto:krrsinfo@gmail.com).
9. KRRS members, associate members, or members of their immediate family or guests who observe any non-compliance with any of the Society's Bylaws, Rules or Policies, must report the occurrence to KRRS at [krrsinfo@gmail.com](mailto:krrsinfo@gmail.com).

**Failure to follow the above rules may result in fines and/or suspension of membership privileges, or membership.**
