CODE OF CONDUCT

KRRS expects all Members and Associate Members to adhere to a certain standard of conduct in order to maintain a positive environment within the Society.

Condescending or disrespectful conduct to KRRS Members, Associate Members, non-members, along with their family members and guests, will not be tolerated. The Society expects your cooperation in ensuring that you are respectful of each individual while enjoying the Access, the lake and neighborhood we share collectively.

The following are some examples of inappropriate behaviour, but this list is not exhaustive;

- Violation of the KRRS Access Rules Policy;
- Violation of the KRRS Bullying and Harassment Policy;
- Violation of the KRRS Privacy Policy;
- Violation of the KRRS Conflict of Interest Policy;
- Excessive drinking at the Access property;
- Engaging in acts of unlawfulness, dishonesty, fraud, theft or sabotage;
- Unauthorized use of KRRS property or property belonging to another Member, Associate Member and/or their family members and guests;
- Using loud or abusive or vulgar language, acting in a threatening or intimidating or coercive manner, or interfering with the activities of another Member, Associate Member, non-member, along with their guests and family members; and
- Presenting yourself in the community in an unprofessional or inappropriate manner as a representative of the Society.

Procedure:

You are expected to use common sense and good judgment regarding appropriate conduct at the Access, the lake and neighborhood we share collectively.

Failure to comply with the KRRS Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension of membership. Please see Complaint, Dispute and Resolution Policy.
